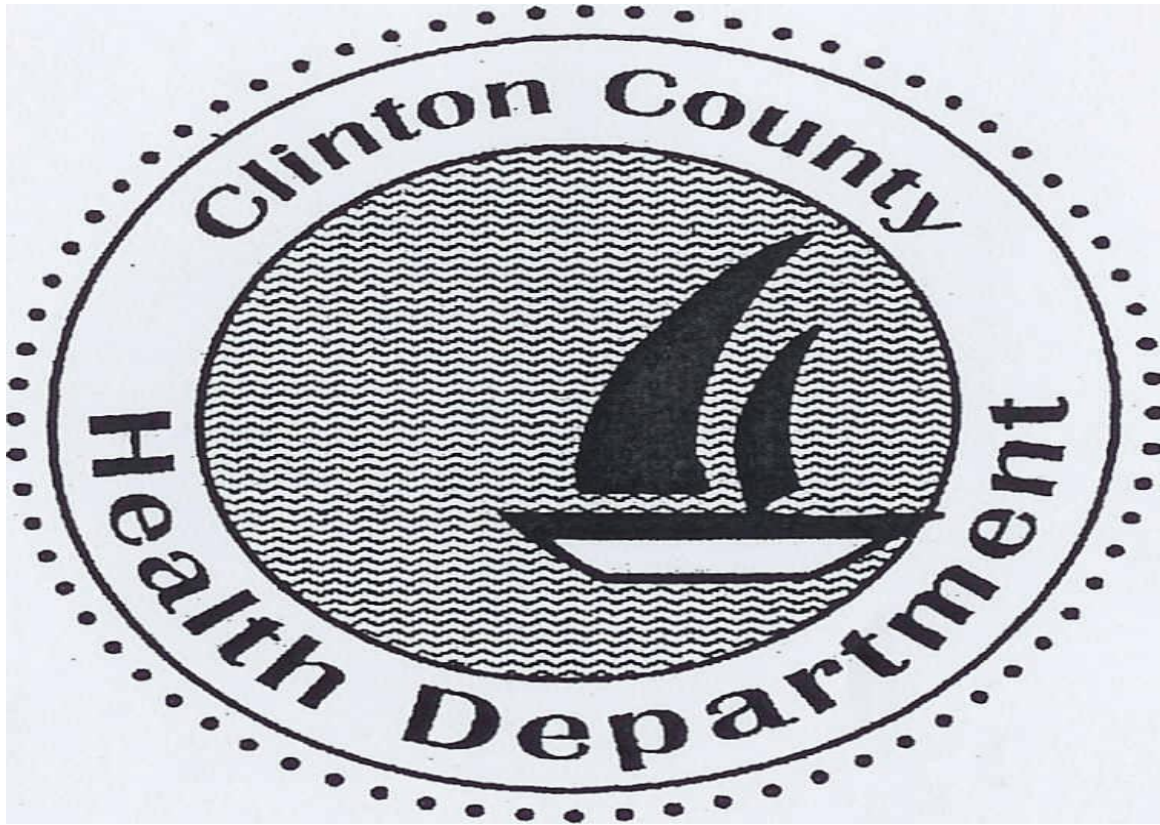

On behalf of the Clinton County Board of Health and our staff, I am pleased to present you with the 2020 annual report of operations. 2020 has been a trying year for everyone in this county. COVID-19 has become the major focus of our staff and administration. The health department set up a contact tracing team to help contain the spread of the virus in our community. Near the end of the fiscal year a vaccine was introduced and we continue to administer shots in our county. We will continue to fight this virus to ensure the health and safety of our community. During this year we hired a new administrator to help lead our health department.

The Clinton County Health Department ended Fiscal Year 2020 with a cash balance of \$1,143,503.84. We continue to look at new opportunities to improve our physical facility and create more space for an expansion of our services. The board of health continues to explore options with our county board, citizens and other stakeholders to determine the best course of action.

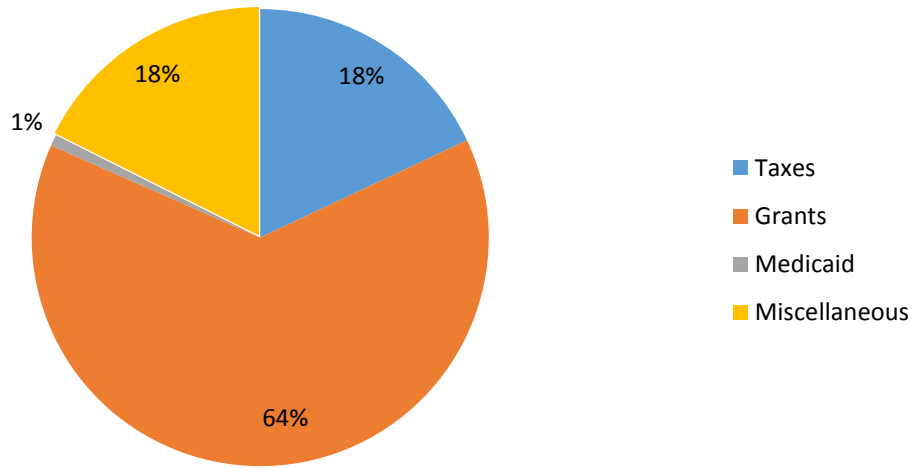
PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS 2020

Making sure the public is safe and ready for an emergency is a priority of the Clinton County Health Department. The Clinton County Health Department has an Emergency Preparedness and Response Program and oversees the Emergency Public Health Preparedness Activities, Cities Readiness Initiative and the Medical Reserve Corp. The Program works closely with community partners to address and prepare for emergencies and potential disasters. This has allowed our department to head the Contact Tracing and Mass Vaccinations efforts of Clinton County.

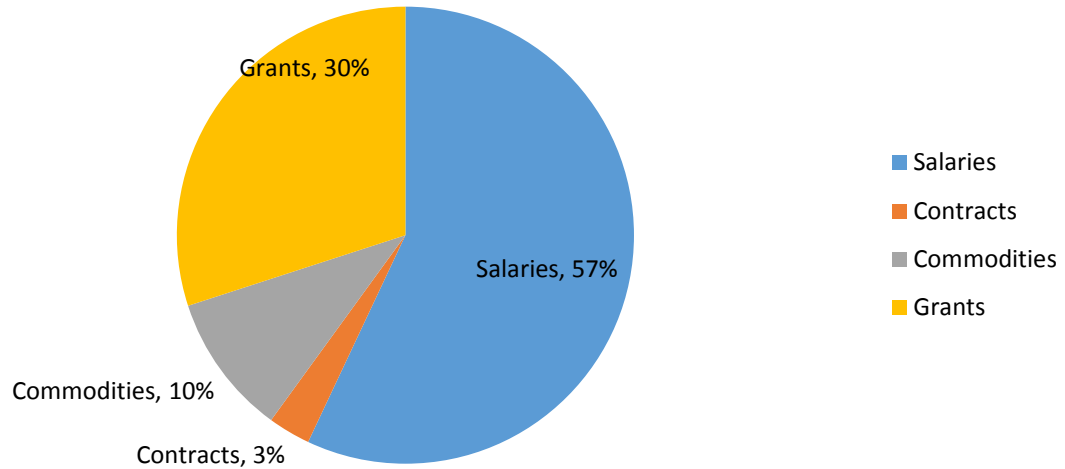
Revenues
